Re-Opening Guidelines During COVID-19

This is What We are Doing to Keep Families and Volunteers Safe

- Reducing class size
- Minimizing resources to prevent the spread of germs while maximizing the gospel message
- Screening leaders each Sunday to include temperature checks and requiring masks/face shields
- Providing more hand sanitizer stations throughout the building
- Creating a flow path to alleviate congestion in the hallways
- Providing monitors to keep restrooms clean for children

This is What We Need Families to Do to Keep Children and Teachers Safe

- Weekly registration is required by Friday at 12 noon.
- Classroom drop off begins at 9:20 for the 9:30 service.
Classroom drop off begins at 10:50 for the 11:00 service.
All children should be picked up promptly to ensure adequate time for cleaning.
- Encourage your child to use the restroom prior to drop off.
- To reduce the number of people in the building, we are asking only one parent per child to drop off and pick up. This includes 3rd-5th graders.
- Masks are required for entry into the children's building by everyone, kindergarten and above; and check-in stickers should be visible.
- Staff will be checking temperatures at check-in. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or greater will not be allowed in the building.
- Please observe posted signs as you walk through the halls. Parents are encouraged to exit the door at the ends of the building closest to your child's classroom. For your convenience, you may want to use the new parking lot located behind the children's building.
- For children in diapers or potty-training, please send diapers or one change of clothing in a gallon-sized zip top bag labeled with your child's name. Labeled bottles or pacifiers will be allowed for newborns and crawlers. No other personal items will be allowed in the classroom.
- A snack of Ritz crackers and water will be served between the services for toddlers and preschoolers attending both hours. No outside food or drink will be allowed. If your child has an allergy, please speak with our Preschool Director.
