### **Primary Duties & Responsibilities:**

1. To lead worship.
  - a Play and/or sing in Sunday Worship.
  - b Have a theological view of worship that aligns with Spotswood Baptist Church. This theological view is rooted in the trinitarian model of worship:
    - i We acknowledge that the Holy Spirit prompts us to worship. (John 14:6, Romans 8:26, Galatians 5:25)
    - ii We present our worship to Jesus Christ, the High Priest of our faith, so that He may perfect our worship; as He worships with us. (Hebrews 4:14-16, Hebrews 2:12, 1 Timothy 2:5)
    - iii We have faith that God the Father receives our perfected worship from Jesus Christ because of His sacrifice on the cross and His resurrection. (Ephesians 2:18, John 4:24)
2. To teach our congregants/worship team this trinitarian model of worship.
3. To oversee all preparations, planning (with the Worship and Fine Arts Pastor), scheduling and oversight for contemporary corporate worship.
4. To recruit, evaluate and train musical talent.
5. To develop worship leaders.
6. To work alongside the Director of Worship Tech in coordination of worship service technical elements.
7. To care for the spiritual welfare of the worship volunteers.
8. To support the implementation of the Worship and Fine Arts Pastor's vision.

### **Secondary Duties & Responsibilities:**

1. To oversee Student Bands.
  - a Rehearse Student Bands
  - b Grow (recruit and teach) student bands in numbers and in ability.
  - c Audition both High School and Middle School Band
2. To lead worship at special events.
3. To provide advise and/or support to our church plants.
4. Any responsibility that the Worship and Fine Arts Pastor sees fit for the role of Associate Worship Leader
