Action: God gives us a proactive spirit to put to use the tools in spiritual warfare.

Ephesians 6:13-18, "Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm. Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and, as shoes for your feet, having put on the readiness given by the gospel of peace. In all circumstances take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming darts of the evil one; and take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the

Spirit, which is the Word of God, praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end, keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints.

Pray: Lord, enhance in me a confident spirit to fight against the Evil One and for You. Let me begin each day clothed in the full armor of God; a belt of truth, breastplate of righteousness, shield of faith, helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit/Your Word. 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We can easily find reasons why we can't slow down enough for more prayer time. Set a realistic schedule for prayer. Set goals you can attain and maintain. Our intimacy with God will grow as we spend more time with God.

Be consistent – consistency is more important than length. Before you know it, five minutes will become 15 minutes and then 30 minutes. You'll enjoy being with God! If you give God the time, He will touch your soul.

Luke 5:16, "But He would withdraw to desolate places and pray."

Jesus' example of praying found throughout the Gospels is a great encouragement for our own pattern of prayer.

Prayer Time: Pray and reflect on some initial thoughts about where to pray, and how long and often you may want to schedule time for prayer. What practical steps will you need to take to make it happen? Ask the Lord for help.
